Berk has fixed the girls' water at the kennels. We need to schedule a work day at the kennels. There will be no Glenmore puppies next year.

Stacy Thompson - We had a great 4 day hunt weekend. Many members went to all 4 hunts. We will continue to have a 4 day hunt weekend when there is no Virginia hunt week.
