Membership Meeting, July 7, 2020

- I. Call to Order - Hugh Sproul called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM.
- II. Minutes - In respect to the election of board members that was held in June instead of April due to COVID-19 restrictions, the election of a secretary was omitted in the minutes. Diane Gibbs was elected secretary along with the other board members in the elections. With that correction, Jenner Brunk made a motion to approve the minutes, John Meyer seconded the motion, and minutes of June 2 were approved.
- III. Treasurer's Report - John Meyer presented the Income and Expense Report, explained that it had been a very good month due to income from the Murder Mystery Ride and the Hunter Pace. - IV. He is going to send out the capping certificates with the shirts. Stacy Thompson reported that since the Hunt Week has been cancelled, and Sedgefield cancelled their event, she is helping to organize a 4 or 5 day hunt weekend in October. So far Oak Ridge, Rockbridge, Stonewall and Glenmore are planning to do this,. She also reached out to Middlebrook but has not heard back yet. Brenda Simmons reported that Ripple will be having an xray to determine the number of pups she is carrying for a July 25 due date. She reported that shots will be done next week, and Jiffy and Lazor still need their retirement homes.
